CLINICAL RESEARCH

- Study of SERM effects on the endometrium including in-office endometrial biopsy, endocervical curettage, transvaginal sonogram, and pap smear
- Study of SERM effects on pelvic prolapse and endometrial polyps including in-office hysterosonography and endometrial biopsies
